

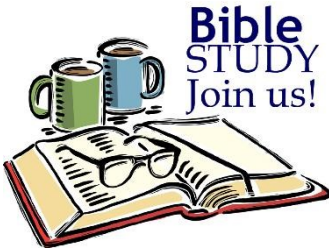

God was present in the song and joy of community surrounding the Root Beer and Hymn Sing at the Slice of Shoreview Celebration this past Friday

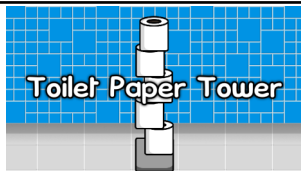
